IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Volunteer Uniform Changes
 - Ahead is providing the volunteer uniforms. Due to supply shortages and factory closures Nike was not able to provide this year.
 - Drop shipping of the uniforms will NOT be available for 2022! **ALL volunteers will need to pick up their uniform package at the PGA TOUR Superstore.** (7603 Turkey Lake Rd. Orlando, 32819)
 - All volunteers will receive a cap- ladies that want a visor will need to exchange it at the Superstore
 - Name tags will be given to you from your committee chairman (not in the uniform package)

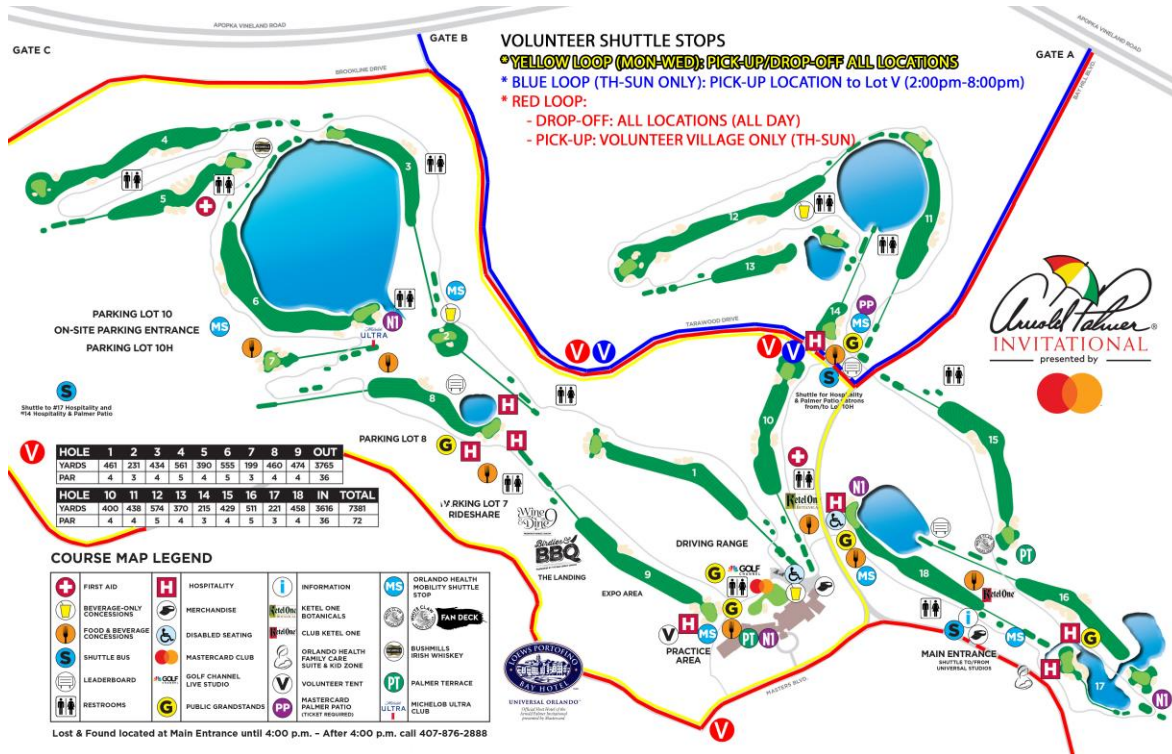
